Ultrasound-Guided Saphenous (Adductor Canal) Block - NSORA
Thereafter, an ultrasound-guided saphenous nerve block (linear 5-12MHz transducer/Vivid I; GE Healthcare, Waukesha, Wisconsin, USA) was conducted distal to the adductor canal, underneath the sartorius muscle^{5,6}(Figure [Figure1a]and andb).b). Both, ropivacaine 0.375% and triamcinolone 20 mg were administered, producing a 50% pain relief.

Ultrasound Guided Sub-Sartorial Saphenous Nerve Block. Overview of the Block. The saphenous nerve is a sensory only branch of the femoral nerve which covers the medial portion of the lower leg to the medial malleolus. It is most commonly used in combination with a popliteal sciatic or lower anterior sciatic block for procedures and injuries of the mid-lower leg and ankle.

The introduction of ultrasound-guided techniques and several studies supporting its use as an alternative to femoral block for total knee arthroplasty have greatly increased the interest in the transsartorial (or "adductor canal") approach to the saphenous nerve.

Cutaneous Nerve Blocks of the Lower Extremity - NSORA
Ultrasound guided saphenous nerve block is considered a INTERMEDIATE skill level block. It can be challenging to image this small nerve in some individuals. Insert a 5-8 cm 22 G needle parallel to and inline with the transducer and the ultrasound beam.

The position of the saphenous nerve in the adductor canal has been well described, originally by Mansour⁷ and later revisited by Hornet al.⁸Gray et al who published an earlier description of ultrasound guided sub-sartorial saphenous block⁹.
